There are thousands of miners here every year to get rid of the dust and other inflictments from the work in the mines of the Ruhr district. During the post-war decade this place served as Headquarters for Occupational Forces and Missions but thanks to the understanding and generous advance of General BISHOP, the former Land Commissioner, the spa -institutions were gradually given back to our administration and since the bath- houses and other amenities were restored to their proper purpose, Salzuflen has made tremendous progress- as you may imagine from the present state of the place. The Park, however, at the moment, has partly been changed into a building-site and therefor we must renounce the Philharmony Concert today-as a new concert-hall is just going to be built. So you will be welcome there at your next visit.

Nature has gifted this Lippe district with several spas and healthresorts- that is why it is called "Heilgarten Deutschlands"but Salzuflen crowns it, I think, and therefore I am specially
glad that you came here to meet us as old and new friends.
